**Morgan County African American Museum Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) Scholarship  
156 Academy Street, Madison, Georgia 30650**

The Morgan County African American Museum is offering two five hundred scholarships to two Morgan County High School Graduates that are pursuing a higher education in a two or four-year college/university or a certification program at a technical school.

**Eligibility Requirements**

The recipients may use the one-time scholarship to attend any accredited college/university or technical school of their choice. The MCAAM Scholarship is not limited to any specific field or career objective and may be used to pursue any academic discipline. Current college or technical students are not eligible. Applicants should demonstrate academic achievement, exhibit leadership ability, participate in school/ community service activities and demonstrate financial need. The scholarship recipients are selected in the spring prior to entering college/technical school for the following fall. Applications are screened during the month of February. By the end of March two recipients will be selected. Notification follows immediately, and a check will be sent to school of the recipient choice and acceptance.

The MAACM Scholarship may be used to cover the cost of tuition, fees, books, room and board, health insurance, general living expense and other school related expenses.

The following requirements must be met by the recipients of this scholarship:

\_\_\_ Completion of Application

\_\_\_ U.S. Citizen or permanent resident

\_\_\_ Graduating senior with a 2.5 GPA

\_\_\_ A typed 500 words essay that speaks to your reasons for pursuing a higher education, how the scholarship will assist with this pursuit, your community/school involvement, and your long-range goals.

\_\_\_ Accepted by an accredited 2 or 4-year college/university or technical school.

\_\_\_ Will be entering first year of college/university or technical school in the fall immediately after high school graduation.
